Re: Raffle permits

Please be advised that all organizations conducting raffles or bazaars must apply for a permit from this office. This permit should be applied for before tickets are sold and at least 30 days prior to the event. This is the law.

In order to obtain a raffle permit you must submit:

- 1) Raffle application.*
- 2) Notarized statement of non-profit.*
- 3) Your Annual Report. (if previously had a permit)*
- 4) A current membership list including all addresses.*
- 5) A \$10.00 filing fee. Make check payable to: Town of Huntington*

No person holding a permit to operate raffles or bazaars shall operate any particular such event unless written notice has been given to the Chief of Police, no less than 30 days prior to the event, of the date, time and place of the event and of any deviation from the information contained in the application for the permit to operate the same.

Any person violating any provision of this article shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00.
