### A. Purpose

It is the purpose of these regulations to protect the public health, safety and welfare by ensuring housing units with no access to public water supplies, the supply of safe drinking water from private wells and to provide for the protection of the Town of Huntington groundwater resources.

### C. Authority

These regulations shall be effective on and after May 1, 1990, and so remain until modified or amended by the Town of Huntington Board of Health.

They are enacted by the Town of Huntington Board of Health under the authority which includes but is not limited to one or more of the following Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter III, Sections 31, 122, 122A, 127, 143, 155, 187, 188; Code of Massachusetts Regulations (CMR) 11.02, and Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 40, Section 54.

Any and all previous regulations concerning private wells are hereby repealed.

### II **Definitions**

### Abandoned Well

A private well that meets any of the following criteria:

- 1. construction was terminated prior to completion of the well
- 2. the well owner declares that the use of the well has been permanently discontinued
- 3. the well is in such a state of disrepair that its continued use is impractical or represents a physical threat
- 4. the well has the potential for transmitting contaminants into the acquifier and the situation cannot be corrected.

### **Board of Health**

The Board of Health of the Town of Huntington or its authorized agent.

# **Certified Laboratory**

Any laboratory which has full certification by the Department of Environmental Protection as provided in the most recent edition of "Certification Status of Commercial Environmental Laboratories."

### Private Well

Any non-public well, serving less than 15 houses and serving fewer than 25 people as defined in 310 CMR 22.02  $\,$ 

# <u>Well</u>

A bored, drilled or driven well or a dug hole with a depth greater than its largest surface dimension, or any other source of water.

### Well Driller

Any person, association, partnership, company, or corporation that constructs wells and is registered with the
